This is an account of David’s **mighty warriors**: Jashobeam, son of Hachmoni, was chief of the Three; he wielded his spear against three hundred whom he killed at one time. And next to him among the three warriors was **Eleazar** son of Dodo, the Ahohite. **He was with David** at Pas-dammim when the Philistines were gathered there for battle. There was a plot of ground full of barley. Now **the people had fled** from the Philistines, **but he and David took their stand in the middle of the plot, defended it, and killed the Philistines; and the Lord saved them by a great victory.**
